





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Social Distancing - Student Desk Configurations



PreK-8 Schools

- Two days in a row with Wednesday as a Virtual Day for all students (i.e. AA-virtual-BB each week)
- 4 hours instruction in-person, end-of-day Distance Learning period
- No lunch or recess, early dismissal for students
- Kindergarten and Integrated Preschool students in half-day programs will be scheduled in the following manner:
 - Half-Day Programs in the AM section will begin at 8:30 and end at 10:40
 - Half-Day Programs in the PM section will begin at 10:45 and end at 12:50


Special Education

- PreK-12 students in self-contained programs (PSD, LLD, BD, MD and Autism)
 - 4-hour in-person instruction, five days per week
- PreK students in a half-day program:
 - AM section - 8:30 a.m. - 10:40 a.m.
 - PM section - 10:45 a.m. -12:50 p.m.
 - PreK students in a half-day program will follow the same AAVBB schedule consistent with our general education program.
- K-12 students(in-class support or resource room program) - same schedule as the general education program.
- Related Services (speech, occupational, and physical therapy)
 - Tele-therapy and in-person therapy

- Masks

- Deep cleaning buses and classrooms
- Hallways clearly marked as one-way or two, one-way lanes
- No lunch or recess

Temperature Taking Upon Entry

- **NJDOE - June 29, 2020**
- **CDC - July 23, 2020**
 - CDC does not currently recommend universal symptom screenings (screening all students grades K-12) be conducted by schools.
 - Parents or caregivers should be strongly encouraged to monitor their children for signs of infectious illness every day.
 - Students who are sick should not attend school in-person.

Childcare

- In-school and out-of-school providers have been contacted.
- Final approval of the District's daily schedule will be communicated to all providers so that they can begin their planning and communications.
- District In-house Programs -
 - A students - Mondays/Tuesdays
 - B students - Thursdays/Fridays
 - Wednesdays – not in operation - additional cleaning.
